

LPN (full-time) in Med-Surg - LPN or RN (part-time) in Special Care Unit (SCU) - LPN's or RN's (pool)

- **LPN** to work on Med-Surg floor 7pm to 7am 3 days/week including every other weekend.
- **LPN or RN** to work in SCU 7pm to 7am (Mon. & Wed. then Mon. & Fri. on repeating schedule) & may work as needed in other units. &
- **LPN's (or RN's)** to work as needed (PRN) for absences in Med-Surg primarily & other units (ER, Surgery & SCU) based on qualifications.

LPN's assist RN's with patient care needs using nursing process & teaching. Perform medication administration, dressing changes, IV therapy, vital signs, hygiene needs & report change in condition or behavior to RN. SCU Nurses monitor & interpret telemetry including cardiac rhythm on on-going basis & provide care to critical patients including ventilator.

Be graduate of accredited/approved program in nursing w/current Illinois LPN or RN license (or temporary work permit). SCU nurses must possess critical care training & Dysrhythmia Reading Certification (or obtain within 3 months of employment for LPN). RN in SCU requires ACLS with PALS preferred. Possess excellent written, listening & interpersonal communication skills, modern office & basic computer skills & CPR certification.

Pool (PRN) LPN's receive \$2/hour extra & RN's \$4/hour extra while part-time receive paid leave benefits & full-time receive all benefits.
